Life is Spiritual Follow Up

We've been taught to think that our life is divided into different categories - everything is either Spiritual or Unspiritual. But the Scriptures teach us that everything is spiritual, and that everything spiritual has real, practical implications for our lives. When we share the Gospel, we must share both by what we say and what we do. And when we serve, we must serve so that our serving always points back to the transformation Jesus offers through his death resurrection. Real sharing is serving, and real serving is sharing!

Questions for Discussion::

1. What in your life do you normally think of as spiritual? As unspiritual?
2. When you think about helping others, do you tend to fall into the Sharing camp or the Serving camp? Why is that?
3. How is Sharing the Gospel supposed to be a spiritual activity? How is it practical?
4. How is serving someone supposed to be a spiritual activity? How is it practical?
- 5a. Where did you serve at Be the Church Sunday? How did you make your worship practical? How did you make your serving spiritual?
- 5b. If you didn't get to serve at Be the Church Sunday, what will you do this week to Be the Church in your daily life?
