Questions for Discussion

- 1. Do you connect more with Chiune Sugihara the diplomat or the light bulb salesman? Why?
- 2. Paul compares us to Christ's body. Why is it significant that Christ's body, the body we make up, is a *broken* body? What would a king's broken body have represented to ancient listeners?
- 3. How does Paul use the body metaphor to challenge all of us who think our gifts and callings are ordinary?
- 4. Share with someone how you think they're gifted. How do you see God working through them? Allow them to share with you as well.
- 5. What new insights have you gained from sharing? What can you do this week use those gifts for the common good?
