



Discussion Guide for “Who Knows God’s Will Best?” *Ask Better Questions Week 4*

Knowledge is power, and we can be tempted to hold ourselves above others when we have more understanding or experience. In 1 Corinthians 8, Paul takes a simple question about eating meat and turns it into a discussion of loving community.

Epiphany Question:

During this season, spend time each week in prayer and meditation over a question about your calling. This week, sit with the question “**Where do I need to pursue unity before being right?**”

Questions for Discussion

1. Where in our culture do you see people more concerned about being right than being unified? What about in the Church?
2. When has being right hurt your relationship with someone?
3. Why was meat sacrificed to idols such a big deal? How was it dividing the Corinthian church?
4. What was Paul’s advice to the Corinthians? How does it apply in today’s culture and in our church?
5. How do you interact with Christians you feel don't understand the Gospel in the same way you do? How can you practice humility with those you might think "just don't get it"?
