Questions for Discussion

- 1. Have you seen *Breaking Bad*? Why does the creator describe the show as "Mr. Chips becoming Scarface?"
- 2. Breaking Bad is a show about 'inevitability'. What does that mean?
- 3. Review Romans 6:19-26. What does Paul mean when he says that the wages of sin is death? How is a wage different from a punishment?
- 4. What are some ways you've seen sin lead to death either literal or metaphorical?
- 5. Review Paul's description of being trapped by sin in Romans 7:21-24. Can you relate to these words?
- 6. Paul says Jesus frees us from being trapped in sin. This sounds like pretty 'churchy' language. What does this mean practically in our struggle against sin in our life?
- 7. How does a practice like a Prayer of Examen help us experience the freedom Jesus offers us?
