Jeremiah invites us into his model faithful presence in a hurting world - one that invites us to look for God right where we're hurting. That's hope.

Questions for Discussion

- 1. What does the word 'hope' mean to you? Do you consider yourself a hopeful person?
- 2. What was Jeremiah's context? Why were his words courageous?
- 3. In imagining what God would do next, what did Jeremiah get wrong? What does that tell us about how we hope for the future?
- 4. What about the world makes you feel hopeless right now? What gives you hope?
- 5. What does it look like for you to hope in this next month?
