### **Questions for Discussion**

- 1. Share a disappointment you've had in the Christmas season. Why are such memories hard to share during this time?
- 2. Consider the metaphor of light. When is light something we welcome? When is it something we shy away from?
- 3. Malachi was a prophet shortly after the return from Exile. Would you have been a family that was returning or one that never left? How would each group experience disappointment?
- 4. Revisit Malachi's words in chapter 3. How did his words challenge each group? What promise did they hold?
- 5. What does it look like to find God in the midst of your preparations for Christmas this week? How can you make space for the Holy Spirit?
