



## Discussion Guide for “Dolores the Investigator (Fives)”

### *La Familia Madrigal Week 8*

Do you know someone who's got a sharp eye for details? Someone who tends to fade into the background, but doesn't miss anything? Someone who has only so much energy for social interactions? They might be an Enneagram Five. These Investigators are a model of curiosity and intelligence. How can they learn to operate not out of scarcity and fear, but abundance and faith? And how do the rest of us help them flourish?

#### **Questions for Discussion**

1. What makes a Five? What is the core lie they believe? How does that shape them? Do you know any Fives?
2. The deadly sin of a Five is avarice. What is avarice? How is it distinct from greed? Why is it a sin?
3. Fives are in the Fear triad. How does fear manifest in a Five's life? How is this countered by the prayer in [Ephesians 3:14-19](#)?
4. Revisit the story of Elijah in [1 Kings 19](#). List the ways this story illustrate God's provision. What does God's provision look like in your life?
5. If you're a Five, what does it look like for you to connect to your emotions this week? If you know a Five, how can you love them well this week?
