Questions for Discussion

3. We're several thousand years removed from Moses and the Israelites at the edge of the Promised Land. What are the cultural forces today that represent life and death?
4. What might it look like for Catalyst to choose life in the next couple of months?
5. How is God calling you to choose life this week?
