#### **Questions for Discussion**

1. When you think of ethics and technology, what issues are at the forefront of your mind?
2. Last week, we explored the impulse to react that gets called Cancel Culture. This week, we explored the means of social organizing. How familiar are you with this second, older meaning?
3. Classical Liberalism prioritizes the individual. How is this a problem when it comes to making ethical choices?
4. Reconsider the funeral of the Whore of Babylon in Revelation 18. Who is mourning at the funeral? What motivates their grief? What does it cost God's people to 'come out of her'?
5. What might it look like for our church to 'come out of' unjust technological systems?
