

Discussion Guide for "Friendship"

Next Level Week 1

We're in the midst of a loneliness epidemic, and far too often, churches are part of the problem. How can that be, when Jesus insists that he made us his friends? What does it mean for a church to take friendship seriously, particularly in the midst of a culture dying to connect?

Questions for Discussion

- 1. Where do you see evidence of a loneliness epidemic?

- 3. What are some of the most common challenges that friendships face? How have you overcome these challenges to maintain strong friendships?
- 4. How does our current church model encourage building friendships? How does it inhibit that?
- 5. As we move toward a new model, what does it look like to be intentional about making it easy to make friends?
